Re: Paediatric Stabilization Program and
Complex Continuing Care On-Call Program - Payment Discount

In accordance with the negotiated terms of the *2012 Physician Services Agreement (2012 PSA)* between the Ontario Medical Association and the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care (the Ministry), discounts have been applied to the Paediatric Stabilization Program and Complex Continuing Care On-Call Program.

As per the 2012 PSA, the April 1, 2013 discount may be reduced if additional savings are identified in the physician services budget.

Paediatric Stabilization Program

The Paediatric Stabilization Program funding amount has been reduced as follows:

- \$1,168.17 per month effective January 1, 2013 (1.76% flow-through reduction from the previous level of \$1,189.10)
- \$1,168.17 (less \$5.84) per month effective April 1, 2013 (0.5% discount)

Values are per month, per physician (up to a maximum of 7 physicians per site).

Complex Continuing Care On-Call Program

The Complex Continuing Care On-Call Program funding amount has been reduced as follows:

- \$325.00 (less \$1.62) per bed effective April 1, 2013 (0.5% discount)

Value is per Ministry designated chronic care and rehabilitation bed per Fiscal Year subject to a minimum payment of \$10,000 (\$9,950 with the discount applied).
