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Re: Electronic Data Transfer Decommissioning December 2014

This is a reminder that the GONet/modem Electronic Data Transfer (EDT) service will not be available after December 31, 2014 and health care providers who are using the legacy EDT service **MUST** migrate to the new Medical Claims Electronic Data Transfer (MC EDT) service to submit medical claims and access claim payment reports.

To access MC EDT you must set up a GOSecure account and enrol in MC EDT. Instructions on how to complete the registration/enrolment were sent to all GONet EDT users in January & February of this year and a follow up letter sent in October. To release the registration information, the ministry will require the secure code word you supplied when registering for the GONet EDT service.
