

ONTARIO'S END-OF-LIFE CARE STRATEGY

The McGuinty government is investing \$115.5 million over three years to improve end-of-life care services for 6,000 more Ontarians at home and in the community.

This year's instalment of \$39 million will ensure that 4,300 more Ontarians can receive the care they need.

The following is a breakdown of the \$39 million investment:

- \$27.1 million for End-of-Life Home Care Funding including Residential Hospice Funding (through CCACs)
- \$6 million for Volunteer Home Hospice Visiting and other Community Support Service agencies
- \$5.9 million to support common practices and infrastructure

Today's investment of \$27.1 million in funding to Community Care Access Centres will provide better access to care, including enhanced levels of nursing and personal support care services in home and in residential hospices. Listed below is a breakdown of this funding:
