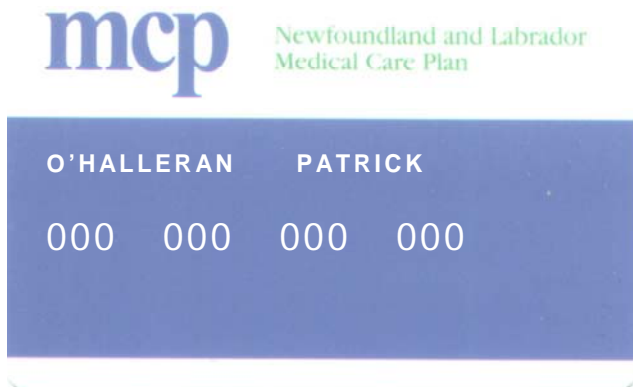
Subject: Newfoundland and Labrador Medical Care Plan Health Card

A new Medical Care Plan (MCP) health card is being issued to all eligible residents of Newfoundland and Labrador. The new MCP health card will include additional information such as date of birth and gender, as well as an effective date and expiry date. All eligible Newfoundland and Labrador residents will be required to register for their new MCP health card by March 31, 2007.

For services rendered on or after April 1, 2007, providers should ensure Newfoundland and Labrador patients present their new MCP health card. The current MCP health cards will not be valid for services rendered after March 31, 2007. The expiry date is not required for claims submissions, however it will be the provider's responsibility to verify the expiration date and record this information in the patient's chart.
