

Notice from the Executive Officer: Refreshed ODB Report Card

We are pleased to share this update on the Annual ODB Report Card.

Today, the OPDP released an updated version of the ODB Report Card containing fiscal year 2016/17 data, including:

- Name change
 - The name has changed from ODB Report Card to **OPDP At A Glance**.
- Creation of two companion products
 1. **OPDP At A Glance: Snapshot Report** – a 2-page PDF document, mostly consisting of infographics, that highlight policy changes and program statistics for the given fiscal year.
 2. **OPDP At A Glance: Data Report** – an Excel file with interactive data tables and graphs. Stakeholders are able to customize their display of data fields, limit the data to a subset of OPDP information, and sort data tables. The Data Report also contains large open datasets.
- Terminology and definitions
 - Several terms and definitions have changed to be more user-friendly and align with common industry standards.

Previously, the Ontario Drug Benefit (ODB) Report Card has been presented as a PowerPoint slide deck with information on cost and claims, as well as services related to the ODB program and other programs funded through the Ontario Public Drug Programs (OPDP). Stakeholders have expressed challenges in using the data to create analyses and summaries.
