Executive Officer Notice: Updated Quarterly Report Back Form for the Ontario Naloxone Program for Pharmacies

Effective **April 15, 2020**, the updated Quarterly Report Back Form (QRBF) will be used for the Ontario Naloxone Program for Pharmacies (ONPP).

The purpose of the QRBF is:

1. To document the outcomes of the individuals who were provided a naloxone kit by a participating pharmacy in the ONPP; and
2. To help assess the effectiveness of the ONPP in addressing and response to the opioid crisis occurring in the province.

The updated QRBF, a fillable PDF, has been streamlined for easier completion and submission by participating pharmacies in the ONPP.

Printing of the form is no longer required. The ministry requires the QRBF to be **submitted electronically by email only** as an attachment to ONPP.QRBF.moh@ontario.ca. One form is to be submitted per reporting quarter. According to the reporting schedule, the next submission date is **April 30, 2020**. However, given the current situation with COVID-19 in Ontario, the next submission date has been extended to **May 31, 2020**.
