To all persons who received the Class Order dated February 1, 2021:

Thank you for your ongoing work to implement my section 22 Class Order under the *Health Protection and Promotion Act* (HPPA), dated February 1, 2021, made pursuant to Section 77.1 of the HPPA, to require every persons under the age of five who enters Ontario via Toronto – Lester B. Pearson International Airport (“Airport”) to undertake a mandatory PCR COVID-19 test.

I am writing to inform you the Class Order is revoked as of Monday, February 22, 2021.

The order is being revoked as the federal government is implementing new travel measures to help limit the spread of COVID-19 and its variants, including testing – making my Class Order no longer necessary

I kindly request you remove all materials and/or references to the Class Order in any materials that are circulated, posted or distributed at the Airport or in any other locations. The Class Order will be removed from the Ministry of Health’s website.
