Indicator description

Demand: Number of clients who were either occupying a long-stay bed or were waiting for placement to a long-stay bed in the LHIN/CCAC area on the report date. Clients who were not already occupying a long-stay bed that were waitlisted for more than one Long-Term Care home and those waitlisted in more than one area were counted only once and only in the area that includes their most preferred choice home.

Supply: Number of long-stay Long-Term Care home beds either occupied or available for occupancy (adjusted for Long-Term Care homes where bed openings and closings are occurring) in the LHIN/CCAC area on the month-end report date. Effective July 2010, Long-Stay bed Supply excludes interim beds.

Placement: Number of placements to long-stay beds in the LHIN/CCAC area in the reporting quarter. Total excludes transfers from one Long-Term Care home to another.
